The content of educational introductory internship in a general education institution is presented by a system of relatively autonomous, but successive stages-modules in relation to each other, aimed at studying the characteristics and inclusion of trainees in various types of professional pedagogical activity, mastering the methods of working with information and optimal ways of solving the set professional tasks, based on current legal norms, available resources and restrictions, according to a systems approach.
Students are invited to study the following issues:
 - infrastructure of a modern educational institution;
 - class team;
 - class teacher in the educational system of the school;
 - subject area "fine arts" in the structure of modern school education;
 - student in the educational space of the lesson.
4. Interim assessment is carried out in the form of a credit test with grade.

B2.C.02(WI) Pedagogical (summer) internship

3. Contents of the internship:
The content of the internship is aimed at promoting the formation of competencies in future bachelors that ensure effective solution of problems in professional activities in the field of organizing summer recreation and additional education for children in educational institutions (school health camp, day camp, etc.), public organization based on the school or other educational organization. Students complete the following tasks:
 - developing a summary and holding an educational event (collective creative work); its subsequent methodological analysis, reflection.
 - developing a summary and holding an educational event (holiday); its subsequent methodological analysis, reflection.
 - artistic decoration of the detachment corner.

The content of the internship is aimed at developing future bachelors' competencies that ensure readiness for pedagogical activity and effective solution of professional tasks in the implementation of the educational process and organization of educational activities of students in general education institutions and institutions of additional education; obtaining skills and experience in pedagogical activity. Students are offered to study the following issues:

- specifics of the teacher's activity in "Fine Arts" in educational institutions;
- structure and management system of the educational institution;
- psychological and pedagogical features of interaction of students during the educational process in "Fine Arts";
- the role of the teacher in the education system of a modern educational institution;
- subject area "Fine Arts" in the structure of education;
- teaching tools, methods of monitoring and assessing the activities of students in "Fine Arts".

B2.C.04(WI) Undergraduate internship

3. Contents of the internship:

The requirements for the organization and content of undergraduate internship are defined by the Federal State Educational Standard of Higher Education. General organizational support for undergraduate internship and direct educational and methodological guidance of internship are provided by the Department of Design, Art Education and Technology. Undergraduate internship is organized in such a way that the student has the opportunity to use the experience accumulated during its passage in preparing the final qualifying work.

At the preparatory and introductory stage, an introductory conference on undergraduate internship is held. The internship supervisor from the university introduces the students to the internship program, their rights and responsibilities, provides program and methodological materials, distributes students to places of internship, appoints a methodologist. A work schedule (plan) for undergraduate internship is drawn up, the deadline, form of collecting and analyzing information in accordance with the topic of the final qualifying work is specified.

The main stage of the internship includes the student's undergoing internship for a specified period (specific dates are established by the curriculum and the schedule of the educational process) and completing assignments stipulated by the

content of the internship. During the main stage of undergraduate internship, the student must prepare the theoretical part of the final qualifying work and outline the main tasks that determine the content of the practical part. In the process of collecting materials for the theoretical part of the final qualifying work, the student must proceed from the fact that the work he or she performs must also have practical value, contain elements of scientific research and include solving certain empirical problems using modern methods. Completion of scientific, methodological and research work includes completion of independent research (experiment, observation, analysis, generalization of experience) on the topic of the final qualifying work; completion of a creative individual assignment for the final conference on undergraduate internship; production of didactic materials, technical means, etc.

During the result-analytical stage of undergraduate internship, students prepare a report that can form an approximate structure of the final qualification work or become material for several sections. At the final conference, the results of the internship are summarized, and the opinion of the methodologist and the head is heard.

- conversations with teachers, class teachers, curators, representatives of parent committees, the council of the educational institution on the organization of the educational process;
- familiarization with the material and technical, didactic equipment of the educational institution, the work of the methods room.

Study of:

- curricula, work programs, calendar plans;
- traditional and innovative forms, means and methods of organizing the educational process in the educational institution;
- individual students and the team in order to design their creative activities;
- psychological and pedagogical aspects of educational activities (motivation for learning, students' attitude to the affairs of the team, relationships between teachers and students, features of students' cognitive activity, etc.).

Carrying out scientific, methodological and research work:

- systematic analysis of students' psychological and pedagogical activities in a diary (observation of students, analysis of creative results, recording of difficulties that arise during pedagogical internship, etc.);
 - completing a creative individual assignment for the final conference on internship;
 - production of didactic materials, technical means, visual aids and handouts for the methodological office.
